# Upgrade of Portrush Road and Magill Road intersection Community information sessions

Dear Resident / Property Owner / Business Owner

We invite you to have your say at upcoming community information sessions on the upgrade to the Portrush Road intersection with Magill Road. Please refer to the details of these sessions overleaf.

## Project background

Since the Australian and South Australian Governments' announcement of \$98 million joint funding for this upgrade, the Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure's planning team has been working towards an evidence based, preferred concept that is informed by community consultation. The upgrade aims to improve travel times, network reliability, and the safety for all users.

The concept plan for the upgrade currently includes:

- Widening on Portrush Road to provide three through lanes northbound and southbound, and additional right turn lanes onto Magill Road eastbound and westbound
- Widening on Magill Road to provide dual controlled left turn lanes onto Portrush Road northbound
- Extension of the right turn lanes from Magill Road onto Portrush Road
- Upgraded pedestrian crossings within the intersection, including new pedestrian crossing and lights
- New and upgraded traffic signals and road lighting
- Dedicated bicycle lanes on the approaches of the intersection
- New kerb and gutter where road realignment and widening is occurring.

The safety improvements will reduce congestion and queuing at the intersection and will provide suitable lane widths for passenger and heavy vehicles as well as cyclists.

A concept design for the upgrade has been prepared and we are inviting the community and stakeholders to provide feedback. Your feedback will help inform the detailed design.
